

MOTORCYCLE TRAINING

Since 1996, Safety Services Nova Scotia has been providing motorcycle rider training for Nova Scotians through a variety of programs and services. Whether you're riding a motorcycle for the first time, looking to get your driver's license, or looking to become more confident on your bike, we have the courses to keep you safe on the road.

TRAINING AND LICENSING COURSE

This is a 20 hour program that provides you with the basic skills and confidence you will need in today's traffic environment. We will supply you with a motorcycle and give you the knowledge, skills, and confidence you need to get the most from your motorcycling experience.

Our instructors are provincially accredited driver examiners, and are able to issue a Nova Scotia motorcycle drivers license upon successful completion of this course.

SKILLS DEVELOPMENT COURSE

Designed for individuals comfortable operating their motorcycle, this 8 hour course will provide a safe and instructional setting for you to challenge your confidence, achieve riding skills beyond the average rider through parking lot and on-road group riding exercises.



SCOOTER TRAINING COURSE

The Scooter Safe Rider Training course is a 20 hour program that provides you with the basic skills and confidence you will need in today's traffic environment. Scooters sizes range from 50cc to 150cc.

Our instructors are provincially accredited driver examiners, and are able to issue a Nova Scotia motorcycle drivers license upon successful completion of this course.

SPYDER TRAINING COURSE

This 12 hour course is designed for individuals who have purchased a CAN-AM Spyder and wish to get licensed and trained to effectively ride their machine. Riders with a current Nova Scotia driver's license will obtain a motorcycle license upon successful completion of this course.



FIREARMS SAFETY & HUNTER EDUCATION

Safety Services Nova Scotia is proud to offer firearms safety and hunter training, including the Canadian Non-Restricted Firearms Safety Course (CFSC), the Canadian Restricted Firearms Safety Course (CRFSC) as well as the Hunter Education Course. These courses are offered in accordance with the requirements and regulations of the federal Department of Justice and the Nova Scotia Department of Natural Resources.
